SEXUAL REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND RIGHTS VIAC MENTORSHIP PROGRAM (VIAC-MP)

Vision in Action Cameroon (VIAC) has learned that community mobilisers (VIAC-MP) can be used in a positive, educational, and awareness-raising way to change community and public opinion in favour of misunderstood SRHR information like abortion, contraception, and sex education.

The (VIAC-MP) can play a vital role in communicating their needs and spreading awareness for human rights and justice, ultimately contributing to the achievement of equality and social cohesion.

The Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights on the job training: organizing an effective community response Fellowship Program 2023 is envisioned to foster deeper local narratives, networks and connections whilst boosting young changemakers to strengthen the SRHR agenda in Cameroon.

This program includes 1-day weekly training for young changemakers. This intensive training will include expert sessions and interactive activities that will hone and harness their skills.



- Exploration and Increased understanding of SRHR issues in Cameroon
- Increased capacity and tools to be conscious global changemakers
- Introduction to innovative and creative methods and approaches to championing SRHR at the grassroots
- Taught and taken through every step of the project pipeline by seasoned experts



During the program, 03 fellows will be chosen and given financial aid and technical guidance, and support to carry out their ideas and strategies. There will be mentorship sessions along with networking opportunities for the fellow to showcase their work and discuss lessons learned and strategies forward. We hope that by providing the necessary tools to young changemakers, we can empower them to tell their stories more authentically and in a manner that will extend their reach beyond their existing networks and make a positive sustainable change toward the acceptance, decriminalization, and progress of marginalized communities.



- A Master's degree in public health, or a related field received within the last five years or a bachelor's with at least two years of experience.
- Experience in planning, conducting, and reporting field activities related to SRH prevention and response programs is beneficial.
- Prior experience, particularly in humanitarian settings, is also desired.

Fellows may have the opportunity to travel internally; therefore, s/he should have a team spirit.
